

Allied Security
Lincoln University Bursary

1. Purpose

Allied Security established these Bursaries in 2008 for the purpose of supporting students attending Lincoln University to further their tertiary education.

2. Number/Value

Three bursaries are available for the academic year, each valued at \$1000.

3. Eligibility

All current or prospective students are eligible to apply. In order to be considered for the Bursary applicants must meet the following conditions:

- 3.1 Be enrolled as a full time student at Lincoln University.
- 3.2 Be a New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident.

4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection shall be

- 4.1 Sound academic ability
- 4.2 Financial situation
- 4.3 Course of study and future ambitions

5. Selection Committee

The scholarship is to be awarded by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of a selection committee, which shall comprise

A representative from Allied Security or nominee,

The Convener of the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee or nominee, A representative from the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee.

- In the situation where the selection committee cannot reach a decision the representative from Allied Security shall have the final say.
- 5.2 The selection committee may refrain from making an award if, in their opinion, there is no applicant of sufficient merit.

6. Tenure

Each Bursary will be tenable for one year. Previous applicants are not eligible to apply in subsequent years.
